And the best is: we see that our comprehensive approach is having a positive effect. People find practical help and gain new hope, learn to believe and actively shape their lives.

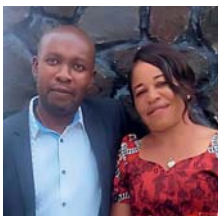

In the past few years, EBM INTERNATIONAL has been able to provide quick assistance after many natural disasters around the world - for example, during floods (Brazil), after earthquakes (Turkey), or hurricanes (Cuba). This gave those affected direct practical help and pastoral care.

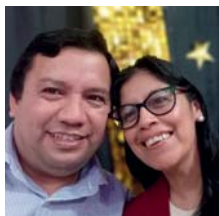

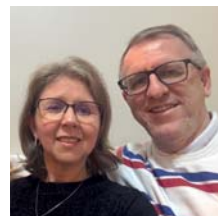

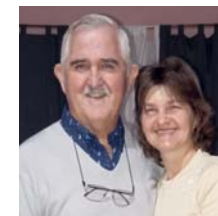

In Sierra Leone, our missionary Christina Döhring teaches at the Evangelical College of Theology (TECT) in Jui, and in Malawi, our missionary Micha Soppa teaches at the Theological College in Lilongwe. In both places, students live and learn together on campus. In addition, there are online offerings for participants who live further away.

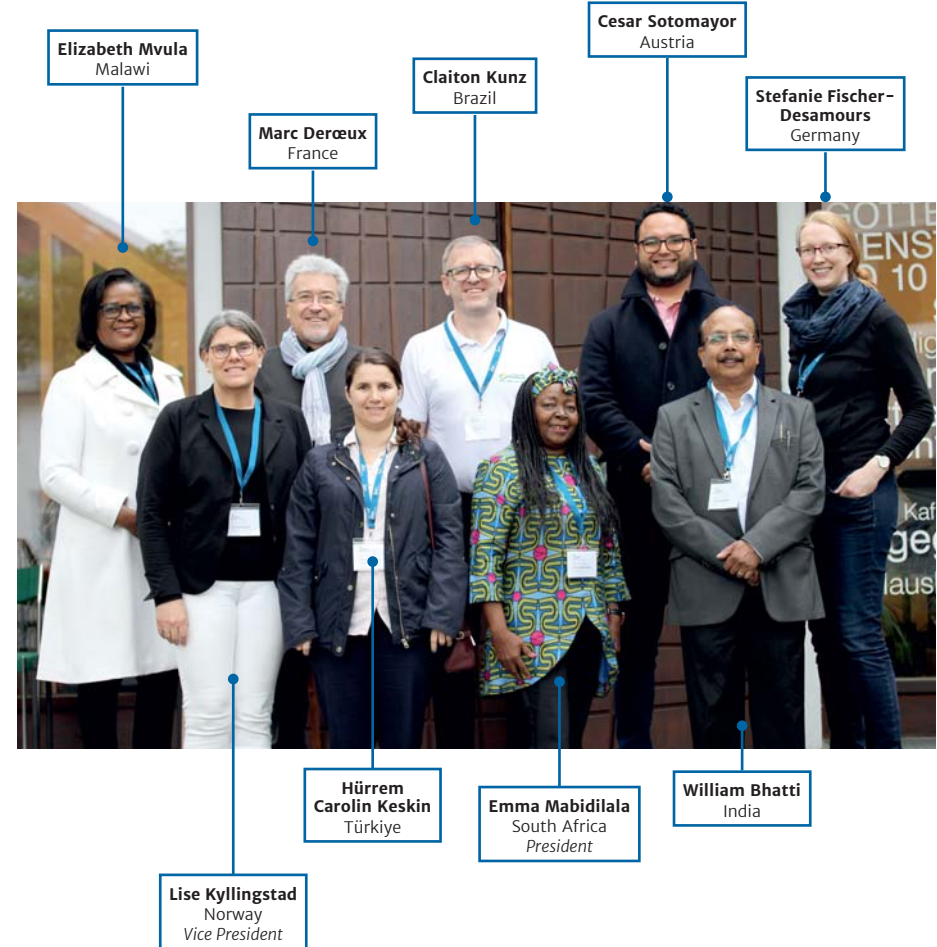
